

IMPORTANT DATES

F O R 2 0 2 4

J A N U A R Y

1: The beginning of contribution room for Tax-Free Savings Account (TFSA).

F E B R U A R Y

21: Netfile/efile opens for the 2023 tax filing season.

29: Deadline for employers, corporations, banks, and financial institutions to issue most T slips.

M A R C H

1: Deadline for RRSP contributions to be considered for the 2023 tax year.

15: 1st quarterly income tax instalment due.

31: Deadline for trusts to issue T3 slips.

A P R I L

30: The tax filing and payment deadline for personal tax returns for the 2023¹ tax year (see June 17 for self-employed individuals) and deadline for filing Underused Housing Tax returns for the 2022 and 2023 tax years.

J U N E

15: 2nd quarterly income tax instalment due.

17: Deadline for self-employed individuals and their spouses to file their taxes (payment deadline April 30).

S E P T E M B E R

15: 3rd quarterly income tax instalment due.

D E C E M B E R

15: 4th quarterly income tax instalment due.

31: Deadline to convert your RRSP to a RRIF or a life annuity if you turn 71 this year.

Important Dates for HST

- Quarterly instalment dates: **April 30, July 31, October 31, January 31**
- Deadline for paying HST owing in excess of amounts paid by instalment: **April 30**
- Deadline to file HST return: **June 17**

Notes:

1. Deceased taxpayers: Tax filing and payment deadline is the later of April 30 and six months following the date of death.

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
